Thur 16th June

- Hadlow Fields open after 1730 hrs for Groups to deliver equipment / erect tentage etc. Groups will be responsible for their own equipment on site at all times – for your information there will be no cover by organisers till fri lunchtime.
- Each Group will have a designated camping area – please keep to this

Fri 17th June

- Site open to Groups to deliver equipment / erect tentage etc from 12:00hrs.
- There will be no vehicular access on to field after 19:00 hrs
- Groups have been allocated a 20min slot between 19:00hrs to 21:00hrs for their Young People to be delivered / arrive at the camp site. Please encourage car sharing to reduce vehicle numbers.
- There are no organised activities fri evening
- All Groups should send a Leader representative to the Team meeting at 22:00hrs in cottage



Sat 18th June

- Day visitors will be collected by buses from the Red Cat Public House, Greasby at 08:45hrs.
- There will no vehicular access into / out of the camp site between 09:00hrs and 09:45 hrs to ensure the safety of the day visitors during their arrival.
- The Viking Experience Opening Ceremony is at 09:45hrs on the main field.
- Activities will run from 10:00hrs thru to 17:00hrs with a 1 hr lunch break.
- Everyone is invited to be part of the District Group photo session at 13:30hrs on the main field
- Following the Viking Battle (17:30 – 18:00hrs) everyone is invited to the Viking Banquet 18:00hrs to 19:00hrs where the organisers will be providing an evening meal.
- The day visitors will be leaving at 20:00hrs, after the Viking campfire, arriving back at the Red Cat Public House in Greasby at approx 20:30hrs. No vehicular site access/egress during this time.
- All Groups should send a Leader representative to the Team meeting at 21:00hrs in cottage

Sun 19th June

- Flag Break is at 09:30hrs on the main field
- Activities will run from 10:00hrs thru to 15:00hrs with a 1 hr lunch break.
- There will be a Scouts Own and closing ceremony 15:00 to 15:30hrs
- Groups have been allocated a 20min slot between 16:00hrs to 18:00hrs for their Young People to be collected / depart site.
- There will be no vehicular access on to field before 18:00hrs.
- Groups will be responsible for their own equipment on site after 21:00hrs – there will be no full time coverage by organisers after this.
